


A GLOBAL ISSUE

- Trapped in jobs through coercion or deception that they cannot leave



USDOT GRANTS AND AWARD



Transit

 Committed \$5.4 million in grants in 2019 to support the prevention of human trafficking and other crimes that may occur on buses, trains, and other forms of public transportation.



Commercial Driver's License Program Implementation

 Awarded over \$1 million in grants in 2019 to combat human trafficking through driver's license standards and programs.



Annual Award

 Established \$50,000 Annual Combating Human Trafficking in Transportation Impact Award.
