- 24.9 million people are victims of forced labor globally
- 5.4 of every 1,000 people are victims of modern slavery
- Trapped in jobs through coercion or deception that they cannot leave

(International Labor Organization 2016)

150 bill	Annual Profit

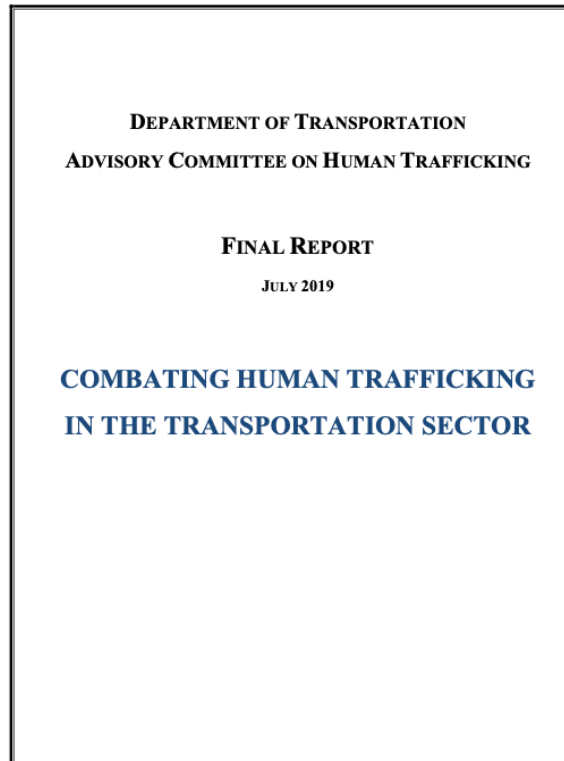

USDOT GRANTS AND AWARD



Transit

- Committed \$5.4 million in grants in 2019 to support the prevention of human trafficking and other crimes that may occur on buses, trains, and other forms of public transportation.



Commercial Driver's License Program Implementation

- Awarded over \$1 million in grants in 2019 to combat human trafficking through driver's license standards and programs.



Annual Award

- Established \$50,000 Annual Combating Human Trafficking in Transportation Impact Award.
