### TOPICS

Data or data analysis tools created pursuant to the **work plan** shall be intended to help address one or more of the following:

- improving maintenance of existing assets;
- rebuilding infrastructure to a state of good repair;
- creating economic development through infrastructure development;
- establishing freight plans and infrastructure that connects the community to supply chain;
- increasing options for communities that lack access to affordable transportation to improve access to jobs, affordable housing, schools, medical services, foods and other essential community services;
- reducing congestion;
- improving community resilience to extreme weather events; and
- other topics (Equity).

## AUDIENCE

BTS shall perform **outreach** to planning and infrastructure decision-making officials in units of local government and other units of government, including a geographically diverse group of individuals from:

- 1. States;
- 2. political subdivisions of States;
- 3. cities;
- 4. metropolitan planning organizations;
- 5. regional transportation planning organizations; and
- 6. federally recognized Indian Tribes.
